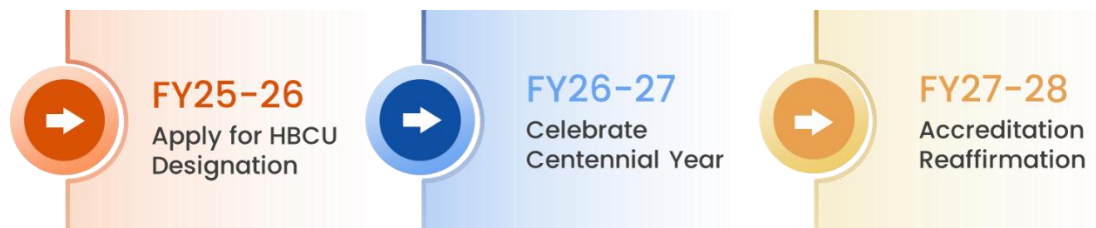
WHO ARE WE?
